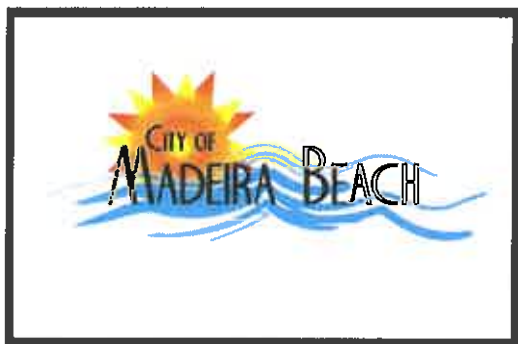

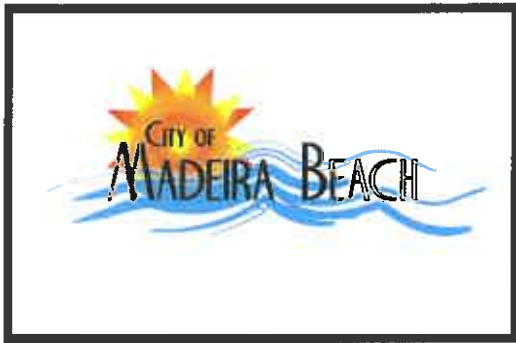
ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF CITIZENS
