

Summary Minutes: Hurricane Preparedness Expo 2026

Event: Hurricane Preparedness Expo 2026

Date and Time: Saturday, April 25, 2026, 10:00 a.m.

Overview

The Hurricane Preparedness Expo 2026 was held to help residents, property owners, and community stakeholders prepare for hurricane season. The event focused on practical preparedness, public safety awareness, available resources, and coordination before, during, and after severe weather events.

Key Topics Discussed

- **Hurricane readiness:** Residents were encouraged to review emergency plans, update supply kits, and prepare homes and businesses ahead of storm threats.
- **Public information and communication:** The expo emphasized the importance of monitoring official city updates, emergency alerts, and reliable weather information.
- **Community resources:** Attendees were directed to local resources and representatives who can provide guidance before and after storm events.
- **Post-storm safety:** Preparedness messaging included safety considerations following a storm, including property impacts, recovery needs, and coordination with public agencies.
- **Resident engagement:** The event provided an opportunity for community members to ask questions and receive preparedness information directly from city representatives and guest speakers.

Action Items and Follow-Up

- Residents should review household hurricane plans and confirm evacuation, sheltering, medication, pet, and communication arrangements.
- Property owners should inspect homes, businesses, drainage areas, shutters, generators, and other storm preparation needs before peak hurricane season.

- Community members should sign up for official alerts and monitor city communications during storm watches, warnings, and recovery periods.
- City staff should continue sharing preparedness resources, contact information, and recovery guidance through official communication channels.
- Questions received from residents should be reviewed and answered through appropriate city channels when possible.
