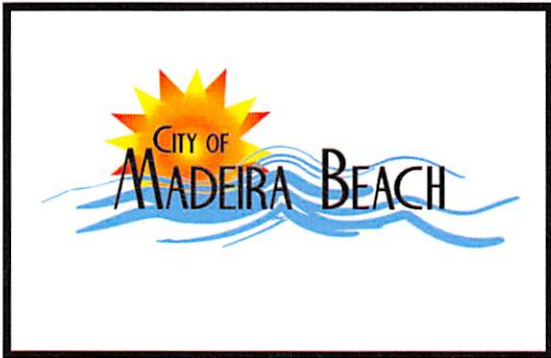

Request: **Section 110-446, Front Yards**
The applicant is requesting a variance to replace an existing 6-foot high fence that exceeds the maximum allowed height of 3 feet within the front yard of an existing multi-family condominium that is located in the R-3 zoning district.

Required: All garden walls, solid fences, or hedges located within the defined front yard shall not exceed 3 feet in height. Open wire and chain link fences, railings and sand screens shall not exceed four feet in height.

Requested: To replace a 6-foot high solid fence within the front yard

Variance: 3 feet of fence height
